## 3. ATTEND PANEL INTERVIEW

After successfully completing 25 hours of construction readiness training, applicants are scheduled for an in-person panel interview facilitated by CityBuild coordinators for an opportunity to study at CityBuild Academy.

- Age 18 or older
- California Drivers License
- Legally authorized to work in the U.S
  - High School Diploma or GED
  - Ability to pass a drug test
- Proof of San Francisco Residency
  - Ability to lift at least 70 lbs
- Commitment to a 12-week training, 40 hours per week
